The **Ticket to Work** is a federally sponsored program by the Social Security Administration. This unique program entitles a person with a disability who is currently receiving either SSI or SSDI benefits to return to work and supplement their income without fear of losing their benefits.

Are You Disabled But Want to Work?


With the **Ticket to Work** Program, qualified beneficiaries receiving SSI or SSDI can receive free job placement assistance. This **Social Security Administration (SSA)** program enables beneficiaries to assign their "ticket" to Certified Employment Network providers. This unique program entitles ticket holders to try to return to work without the fear of losing their benefits.*

Employment Options, a certified employment network, helps ticket holders find suitable work. Because we have been in business for over 20 years, we have established relationships with companies who seek our pre-screened candidates. This program is completely voluntary and offered at no cost; active "ticket" holders are **EXEMPT** from medical review.

In order to qualify for free job placement:

- You must be between the ages of 18-64
- You must be receiving SSI or SSDI benefits
- You must have an assignable "ticket to work"



The **Ticket to Work** program offers people on disability benefits an opportunity to work, save money or pay off bills during their trial work period and longer.



*Once beneficiaries assign their ticket to an employment network and get a job, all SSDI cash benefits for a 9-month trial work period and health benefits do not change. Extended Medicare benefits are available to ticket holders for up to 8 1/2 years for a small premium.

All of our job opportunities are from highly reputable firms. Once applicants are pre-qualified, many of our candidates are placed quickly in jobs working from home in customer service and tech support.

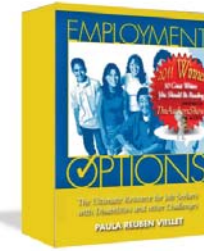
