



WIPA CWIC and Community Partner Work Incentives Counseling Initial Training and Certification Program

Initial Training Program Description

The Virginia Commonwealth University initial training is designed to provide professionals with the basic skills and knowledge they need to deliver work incentive counseling services to Social Security disability beneficiaries at a beginning level. The initial training is five (5) days in duration and is delivered in a classroom setting by two skilled and experienced NTDC trainers. After completing the initial training, participants are able to enter and complete a rigorous series of assessments and clinical exercises that will result in Social Security recognized certification.

The Initial Training is intensive and conducted over a five-day period. All participants must attend and participate in all five days of training. In addition to the training manual, we provide participants with extensive reference materials and tools to assist in on-going development of skills and technical information essential to providing effective and efficient work incentives counseling services.

Initial Training Eligibility and Registration Priorities

The CWIC and Community Partner Initial Training is open to WIPA project staff and their subcontractors, as well as staff of community partner organizations. To be eligible to participate, all registrants must commit to full participation in all components of the CWIC initial training and certification process.

While community partners are invited to register, please note that there is frequently a waiting list for the Initial Training classes. The VCU NTDC must adhere to specific registration priorities established by Social Security in confirming participation for a particular session. Final decisions regarding training acceptance are made by Social Security officials.

Important: There is no fee to participate in the Initial Training and Certification Process for those approved to attend. However, all approved participants are responsible for their own travel, lodging and meal expenses.
